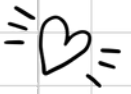


LESSON PLAN

Lesson: Substitute/Finished Early



Grade: 6-8

Subject: Art

Topic: Drawing

Lesson Focus & Goals:

Care Through Coloring allows high school art students to connect with children in hospitals through the creation of coloring pages. Students will focus on creating outlined coloring pages for the program.

Materials:

- 8.5 by 11 inch white paper
- Pencil and eraser (or a device for a digital drawing)
- Black thick tip marker

Objectives:

Create an outlined, black and white coloring page for the Care Through Coloring program.

Activities:

-Each student will work on creating the outline of a coloring page based one of these themes:

- Mythical creatures
- Sports
- Nature
- Characters
- Vehicles
- Animals
- Abstract
- Food

- Coloring pages cannot portray violent, political, or religious imagery
- Basic sketch of the page is completed on the 8.5 by 11 inch sheet of white paper
- Students should outline their designs with a black thick tip marker
- Once designs are complete, students can a.) submit to teacher, b.) submit to teacher, c.) email finished product to carethroughcoloring@gmail.com or scan the QR code to the email
